After distorting the side panels the whole car was painted with an airbrush. It was then lettered for a friends railroad using parts of Gondola decal lettering and individual letters for the reporting marks.. (I made the first one for him and I liked it so much that I did one for me.) It was weathered with weathering powders with with an extra dose of new rust to highlight the unpainted patches. A-Line drop steps and Kadee trucks and couplers, which were also weathered with the powders.
